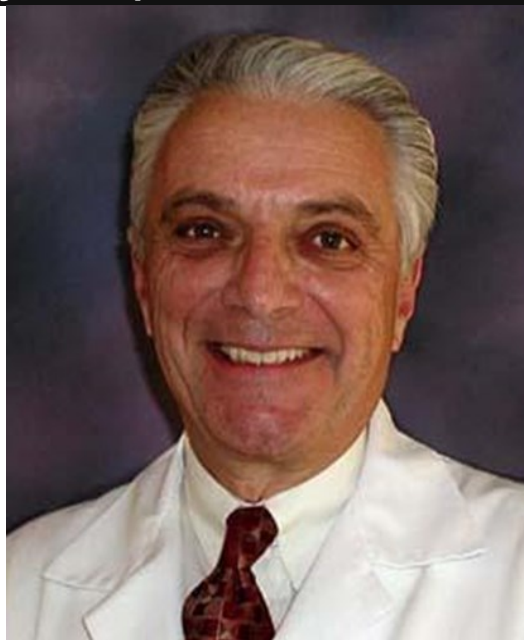

Leading the charge in research into how adverse childhood experiences affect adults, he is co-principal investigator of the internationally recognized Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) Study, a long-term, in-depth, analysis of over 17,000 adults. This study famously revealed a powerful relationship between our emotional experiences as children and our physical and mental health as adults.
